(b) The question papers of Written Test will be bilingual i.e. English and Hindi. However, the questions on the portion of English Language subject will be in English only. The syllabus will be based on Intermediate for LDC and Matriculation for other posts/trades.

(c) <u>Skill Test</u>. Only those candidates qualifying and making it to merit of written test will be called for skill test, wherein, they will be tested in practical aptitude tests for the post applied for. LDC applicants should be well versed with computer knowledge and applications related to MS Word, Excel, Powerpoint, accounts etc.
